The selected representative paper must already be published in hard copy or in electronic form with specific volume and page numbers. Should there be one or more co-authors, a consent form must be signed by all co-authors and submitted along with the representative paper.
- 5. A summary of research accomplishments and future research objectives.
- 6. A teaching proposal.

[Teaching proposal should include at least one course syllabus of Silviculture, Tree Physiology, or Tree Ecophysiology.]
