

Foreign Language Proficiency Requirements for Master's Program Students of the
School of Forest Environmental and Resources, National Taiwan University

I. English

1. Pass the High-Intermediate Level (First Stage) of the General English Proficiency Test (GEPT).
2. A score of 550 or above on the Paper-Based TOEFL (PBT TOEFL).
3. A score of 213 or above on the Computer-Based TOEFL (CBT TOEFL).
4. A score of 79 or above on the Internet-Based TOEFL (IBT TOEFL).
5. A score of 6 or above on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS).
6. A score on the Foreign Language Proficiency Test (FLPT) equivalent to the High-Intermediate Level (First Stage) of the GEPT, as determined by the Language Training and Testing Center.
7. A grade of B or above on the Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE).
8. A score of 750 or above on the Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC).
9. Completion of "Online English for Postgraduates (II)" (AdvEng7002) or "Online English for Postgraduates (III)" (AdvEng7003) at NTU.
10. Holding a degree from a university in an English-speaking country that is listed in the Ministry of Education's reference list.
11. Other English proficiency tests recognized by the Online English Program Planning Committee and approved by the General Education Committee.

II. Languages other than English

The language proficiency items and evaluation standards for languages other than English shall be handled by the items and criteria listed in the Ministry of Education's current year Public Study Abroad Examination Guidelines applicable to the student's year of admission.
