Distinguished Professor Yuan-Chung (Oliver) Lin

Distinguished Professor Yuan-Tsung Lin specializes in green energy, waste reutilization, air pollution control, and circular economy. He is a Distinguished Professor at National Sun Yat-sen University, ASE Chair Professor, and Convener at the National Science and Technology Council. He previously served as Director of the Tainan Environmental Protection Bureau.

He has published 180 SCI papers (64 in the past five years) and holds 20 patents in bioenergy and pollution control. His work has received international awards, including a gold medal in Warsaw and a silver medal in Silicon Valley, as well as the ScholarGPS Highly Ranked Scholar and NSTC Outstanding Research Award.

During his public service, he established Taiwan's first eco-friendly joss paper furnace, improved incinerator performance, and promoted solar energy, making Tainan a leading city in environmental energy generation. He also maintains active international collaborations, demonstrating strong global impact.
